Four years ago, we embarked together on a campaign called *Prepare the Way*. The stated goal of that campaign was to promote faithful stewardship of financial resources among all of our families. Other goals were to reduce indebtedness and purchase additional land for future needs. I am happy to report that *Prepare the Way* was successful! Not only have we seen significant growth in giving to the general ministry plan, but also incredible increases in missions and benevolence stewardship. Your faithful giving enabled FBC Keller to be in position to add a new education and office building in 2009 which will enable us to reach many more families for Christ in years ahead.

Now, we stand on the starting line of the next leg of the church's journey. Our community and region is expected to continue its numeric growth for 15-20 more years. If we are to accommodate the expected growth in our church, we must again focus our energy and resources on the task.

On April 19th, we will launch a new stewardship campaign called, *Find Us Faithful*. My 5 week sermon series by the same name will correspond with each year in this 5 year capital campaign. Our goal is to help every family in our body grow in the grace of biblical stewardship. We plan to offer biblical training in the area of finances designed to help families reduce anxiety and promote generosity. Our two campaign goals are; 1) to pay the \$6.5 million dollar cost of the new building and 2) 100% family unit participation. These are challenging but realistic goals. By working together to meet these goals, we will position FBC Keller to embrace the needs of a growing community.
